

The Tearoom was built in 2009. The aim was for it to be small stand-alone building within a mature landscape, giving views of the lake and Italian gardens.

Although now it is surrounded by additional structures, it was designed to blend in when viewed from any direction, including above and below. (The attached picture taken from the rear shows the original intention)

Although quite a small building the use of full, frameless glazing and the flush continuation of the floor and roof finishes from the inside to outside gives an impression of space when inside. Bringing the outside in.

It was shortlisted for the RIBA Regional Architecture Awards.
